The Audrey Hepburn Children's House (AHCH) at the Joseph M. Sanzari Children's Hospital in Hackensack, New Jersey is seeking a board-certified/board-eligible child abuse pediatrician or pediatric nurse practitioner for an attending staff position. The AHCH is one of four state-designated regional diagnostic and treatment centers for child victims of maltreatment and serves the six northern counties of New Jersey. The focus of the AHCH is to provide comprehensive medical and mental health evaluations in a family-centered, friendly environment. The AHCH performs close to 600-700 medical evaluations each year. The highly trained staff includes physicians, nurses, psychologists, social workers, Child life specialists, and secretarial support staff. The AHCH is looking for an individual with experience in performing medical examinations in child physical and sexual abuse (with the use of colposcopy) and neglect.

Direct medical responsibilities will include medical evaluations of suspected victims of child physical and sexual abuse, medical follow-up, inpatient and outpatient consultations, medical record reviews and court testimony. The clinician will be expected to take a leadership role in community/law enforcement/judicial education about child maltreatment and motivated to do child maltreatment research. Participation in county multidisciplinary team meetings and statewide committees like the New Jersey Task Force for Child Abuse and Neglect (Prevention and Protection subcommittees) is also expected. No pediatric primary care is required.

Salary is competitive and includes a full benefit package.
